MEET "THE POINTE " (MEMORY CARE)

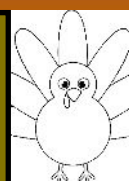
WILLIS "RUSTY" CLINE

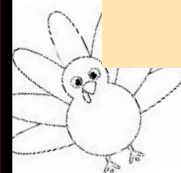
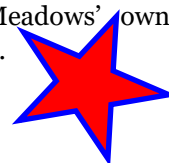

The daughter of a Village community member gifted her passed on father's (who was an Army veteran) electric chair to one of Spring Meadows' own veterans.



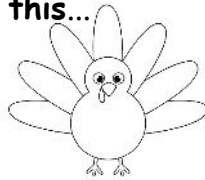

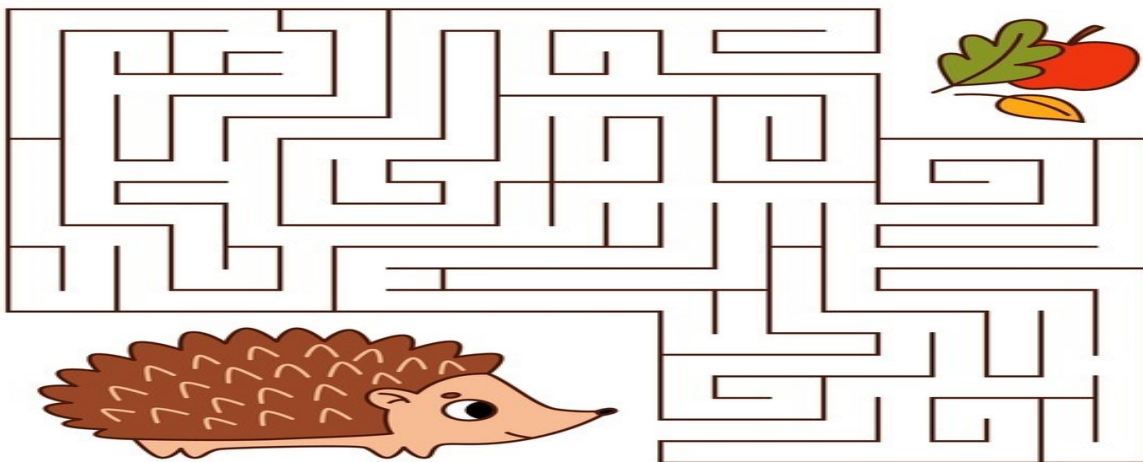

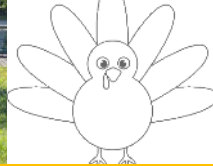
