### Loyie Loyie Lives On

Some call "Louie Louie" the most popular party song of all time. Others call it the most incomprehensible. Try your best to decipher the lyrics on April 11, International Louie Louie Day, in honor of composer Richard Berry's birthdate in 1935. Berry recorded the first version of this song, with the Pharoahs signing along, in 1957. But it was the Kingsmen who made "Louie Louie" a hit in 1963.

A year later, the FBI opened an investigation into the song's mysterious lyrics. One concerned listener believed they contained obscene language. After months of analysis, the FBI concluded the song lyrics were unintelligible. Today we know that it is a simple song about a seafaring man pining for his love as he makes his way to see her in Jamaica.
