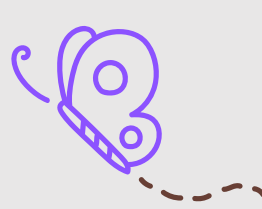

Mothers day



The Mother's Day holiday in the United States was started by Anna Jarvis. She wanted to honor her mother, whose dream it was to have a day that celebrated mothers. On May 10, 1908, the first official observance of Mother's Day was held at Andrews Methodist Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia. (The church is now known as the International Mother's Day Shrine.) Within five years, almost every state was observing the day. In 1914 President Woodrow Wilson made it a national holiday.



Memorial Day

Memorial Day began in about 1866, after the American Civil War. People wanted to honor the soldiers who had died in that war's battles. Women's groups began laying flowers on soldiers' graves. Because the day included decorating graves, it was originally called Decoration Day. After World War I (1914-18) the name of the holiday was changed from Decoration Day to Memorial Day. For many, the holiday also signals the beginning of summer.

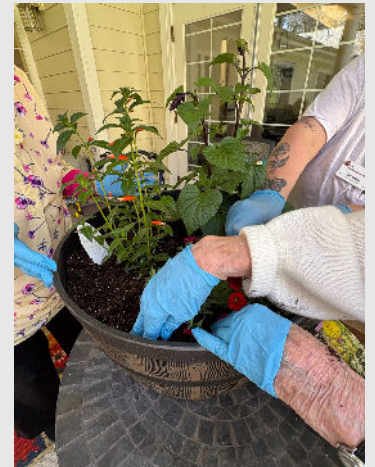


Garden Club

Employee of the Month

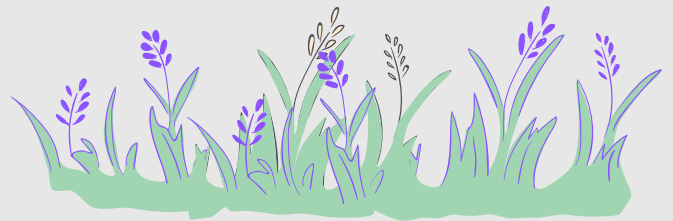
