#### Heart Throb Of the Silent Screen

He was born Rodolfo Alfonso Raffaello Pierre Filibert Guglielmi devoted fans knew him as Rudolph Valentino, and he was one of Hollywood's earliest stars prototypical tall, dark, and handsome Italian—a perfect onscreen hunk. After dancing a tango in The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse, he became a national sensation. His sudden death on August 23rd,

1967, threw his legions of fans into hysteria. Some even attempted di Valentina D'Antonguolla, but his suicide. Tens of thousands visited his open casket in New York City, where mourners rioted and broke a plate-glass window at the funeral of the silent era. Valentino was the home in the hopes of getting in for a final glimpse of the star. A reported 100,000 mourners lined up outside the church where services were held. By train, Valentino's body made its last trip to Hollywood for a final silent goodbye.
